A privilege to <u>Ken Martin</u>, as applicant, to place the following obstruction or excavation within the Town of Warner highway at the following location:

Culvert in Section 24 on Madison Ave

This privilege is granted to Reveen Burkholder, as applicant, to place the abovedescribed obstruction or excavation within a town highway is subject to all the following conditions:

- A. The applicant assumes primary liability for damages to persons or property by reason of the granting of the privilege.
- B. The applicant is obligated to remove the obstruction or excavation upon 10 days written notice by the town board or its agent.
- C. The applicant waives the right to contest in any manner the privilege or its revocation, or the amount of compensation charged the applicant by the town.
- D. The applicant is required to file with the town board a bond that does not exceed \$10,000 that reverts to the town and to any third parties that may be required to secure the performance of the condition specified.
- E. The applicant is required to pay compensation to the general fund of the town in the amount of \$0.00.
- F. The applicant is not entitled to any damages from the town, it's officers, officials, agents, or employees for the removal of the obstruction or excavation, and if the applicant, as the holder of the privilege, does not remove the obstruction or excavation upon notice by the town, it shall be removed by the town at the expense of the applicant.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this resolution as required under s.60.80, Wis stats.
