

TOWN OF WARNER
MINUTES
September 15, 2010

Regular monthly meeting for the Town of Warner was called to order by Town Chairman Ralph Smrecek Jr.

Supervisor present: Charles Suda and Bruce Elmer
Others present: Roger Sonnentag, Jerome Krempasky, Tammy Schmidt, and 23 residents.

Open Forum: None

The minutes of August 10, 2010 meeting were read and approved.

Treasurer report was approved as presented.

Motion Bruce Elmer, seconded Charles Suda, to pay all the monthly bills as presented. Motion carried.

Motion Ralph Smrecek Jr., seconded Charles Suda to approve the assessor contract with Prochnow Assessing for the 2010 assessment. Motion carried.

Explanation of garbage pick-up and recycling bid was presented by Tammy Schmidt of Express Disposal to the residents. Dale Marth of Veolia did not attend. Tammy Schmidt answered concerns from the residents and the board pertaining to the issue. By a show of hands, 19 for and 9 against, the residents wanted mandatory garbage pickup.

Motion Charles Suda, seconded Ralph Smrecek Jr., to have Express Disposal handle the town's recycling and mandatory garbage pick-up, with the town paying for the recycling and any fuel service charges, and Express Disposal doing the billing for garbage pick-up. In the event that residents did not pay for the garbage service the Town would pay the bill at the annual rate and place it as a special charge on their next tax bill. Motion carried.

Express Disposal will be distributing recycling bins and literature on the recycling and garbage pick-up in December.

Motion Ralph Smrecek Jr., seconded Bruce Elmer to gravel Riplinger Road from State Hwy 73 to Central Ave getting the gravel from Boon Construction. Motion passed 2 to 1 with Charles Suda voting no.

Motion Bruce Elmer, seconded Charles Suda to approve the liquor license for Toni Becker dba Greenwood Galley and Pub. Motion carried.

Motion Ralph Smrecek Jr., seconded Bruce Elmer to revise the Recycling Ordinance adopted in 1994. Motion carried.

Recycling Ordinance was revised.

Discussion on possible consolidation with another municipality on shared use of ballot counting machine. Tabled until a later date.

Motion Charles Suda, seconded Bruce Elmer to transfer \$30,000.00 from the checking account to the machinery fund. Motion carried.

Next regular Town meeting is set for October 12, 2010 at 8:00 p.m. at Town Hall.

Motion Bruce Elmer, seconded Ralph Smrecek, Jr., to adjourn. Motion carried.
