

TOWN OF WARNER
MINUTES
February 8, 2011

Regular monthly meeting for the Town of Warner was called to order by Town Chairman Ralph Smrecek Jr..

Supervisors present: Charles Suda and Bruce Elmer
Others present: Roger Sonnentag, Jerome Krempasky, numerous residents

Open Forum: Discussion on mandatory garbage pickup. Residents in attendance were not happy with having to participate in program. It was explained that the town is under a three year contract and nothing can be done at the present time. The residents were told that in three years, after the contract expires, the board will ask for input from the resident again, as was done before the existing contract was agreed to

The minutes of the January 10, 2011 meeting were read and approved.

Treasurer report was approved as presented.

Motion by Charles Suda, seconded by Ralph Smrecek Jr., to pay all of the monthly bills as presented. Motion carried.

Discussion on the personal property of Terry Hebert. It was decided to contact an attorney to compose a letter stating that the Town of Warner does not accept personal property taxes on a payment plan.

Discussion on garbage pickup for the Kenny Kitzhaber and Jerome Briski property. It was decided that the Kitzhaber property should be treated as rental property. Jerome Briski said that he did not know about the service, so he felt that he should not have to pay for January. It was stated that a letter was mailed by the clerk in August, another letter was mailed by Express Disposal in November of which neither letter was returned to sender. There also in the Town Annual Newsletter sent out with property tax bill was notification of the service. It was decided that he should pay for the January service.

Motion Ralph Smrecek Jr., seconded Charles Suda, to Have the town pay the cost of replacement fire numbers signs that are illegible. Any resident wanting new fire number sign that is not illegible must pay for it themselves. Any new fire numbers will be paid for by resident. Motion carried.

Next regular Town meeting is set for March 8, 2011 at 10:00a.m.
